Kingdom Values - To bring what God values and what we value into alignment.

Values - The underlying assumptions and core convictions that consistently shape your decisions and behavior. Your values are revealed in your behavior and not in your belief system.

Discussion Question - What does it mean to be Holy?

The Call to be Holy 1 Corinthians 1:2

- Sanctify - Hagiazō - set apart for God

Since Every believer is sanctified in Christ Jesus a common NT designation for all believers is Saints or "Holy Ones" . Thus Sainthood or sanctification is not an attainment, it is the state into which God, in grace, calls sinful men, and in

which they begin their course as Christians. (W. E. Vine expository Dictionary of N. T. Words)

Call to Sexual Purity (our Actions) 1 Thessalonians 4:7-8

Holy - Hagios - separated- Among the Greeks, dedicated to their gods. ..."hence in scripture in its moral and spiritual significance, separated from sin to God." (W. E. Vines) "It is more than outward cleansing, something more than pure and free from defilement, it is more comprehensive - it is characteristically godliness" (loosely quoted from G.B. Stevens, in Hastings' Bib. Dic.)
